

# **BIG STONE COUNTY LAND AND RELATED RESOURCE MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE AMENDMENT**

THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BIG STONE COUNTY, MINNESOTA,  
HEREBY ORDAIN:

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDMENT TO SECTION 6.3.1. OF THE BIG STONE  
COUNTY LAND AND RELATED RESOURCES MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE,  
1998, passed and approved by the Board of County Commissioners on June 16,  
1998.**

Section 6.3.1 of the Big Stone County Land and Related Resources Management Ordinance,  
1998 is hereby amended to add the following under Section 6.3 Minimum Requirements –  
Setback & Height:

- 6.3.1.1. Where residential structures were erected prior to December 30, 1971,  
additions including, but not limited to porches, patios, decks, sunrooms  
and garages may be attached with a setback of 100 feet to the centerline as  
long as they are outside the right-of-way and do not exceed 1000 square  
feet in size.

This Ordinance Amendment shall become effective and be in force from and after its passage,  
approval, publication and recording in the office of the County Recorder.

All other terms and conditions of the Big Stone County Land and Related Resources  
Management Ordinance, 1998 shall remain in full force and effect.
