BIG STONE COUNTY SHORELAND MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE AMENDMENT

THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BIG STONE COUNTY, MINNESOTA,
HEREBY ORDAINS:

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDMENT TO SECTIONS 5.2.1.2. AND 5.6.2.1. OF THE BIG
STONE COUNTY SHORELAND MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE, 2004, passed and
approved by the Board of County Commissioners on June 15, 2004.**

Sections 5.2.1.2. of the Big Stone County Shoreland Management Ordinance, 2004 is hereby
amended to add Section 5.2.1.2.6 as follows:

Big Stone County Shoreland Management Ordinance, 2004

5.2.1.2. Additional Setbacks for Structures

The following additional structure setbacks apply, regardless of the
classification of the waterbody:

	<u>Setback From:</u>	<u>Setback (in feet)</u>
5.2.1.2.6.	Storage structures no larger than 250 sq. ft. in size shall be allowed a sideyard property line setback of 10% of lot width, whichever is least.....	10

Section 5.6.2.11. of the Big Stone County Shoreland Management Ordinance, 2004 is hereby
amended to read as follows:

5.6.2. Agriculture Use Standards

5.6.2.1. General cultivation farming, grazing, nurseries, horticulture, truck
farming, sod farming, and wild crop harvesting are permitted uses if
steep slopes and shore and bluff impact zones are maintained in
permanent vegetation or operated under an approved conservation plan
(Resource Management Systems) consistent with the field office
technical guides of the local Soil and Water Conservation District, as
provided by a qualified individual or agency. The shore impact zone
for parcels with permitted agricultural land uses is equal to a line
parallel to and 50 feet from the ordinary high water level.

This Ordinance Amendment shall become effective and be in force from and after its passage, approval, publication and recording in the office of the County Recorder.

All other terms and conditions of the Big Stone County Shoreland Management Ordinance, 2004 shall remain in full force and effect.
